





Causes

- Widespread discontent (dissatisfaction) among all Russian social classes
 - Strikes and riots
 - Bloody Sunday (1905)
- Weak leadership of Czar Nicholas II
 - Resistant to change
 - Rasputin
- Russian defeat in Russo-Japanese War (1905)
- Losses in WWI
- Food shortages



Effects

- Abdication of Czar Nicholas II
 - Execution
- Growing power of soviets
- Bolshevik takeover under Lenin
- Peace with Germany under Treaty of Brest-Litovsk (1918)
- Civil War (1918 1920)
- Bolshevik control of government
- Destroyed economy

Rasputin





- Gained the trust and friendship of Czar Nicholas and his wife for "healing" son's hemophilia
- Gained power and influence
- Opposed reforms
- Increased corruption
- Assassinated by young aristocrats in December 1916
 - Poisoned
 - Shot several times
 - Thrown in river





Russian Revolutions in March & November 1917

February Revolution (March 1917)

- Provisional government established, mainly led by aristocrats and nobles
 - Insisted on staying in the war
- Soviets formed, local councils started gaining power
 - Workers, peasants, soldiers

Germany had a secret weapon!

• Marxist, ruthless, charismatic, excellent organizer


Bolshevik Revolution (November 1917)

- Bolsheviks, "one of the majority" seizes power
 - Largely consists of workers and peasants (proletariats)
- Russian Civil War (1917-1922) starts between Red Army and White Army
 - Red Army Communists
 - White Army Anti-communists
 - Allies sent soldiers to support
 - U.S. sent 11,000 soldiers

Bolshevik Revolution

Following the initial March Revolution in 1917 that overthrew Czar Nicholas, another revolution happened shortly after

- Soviets formed, local councils
- Lenin, leader of the Bolsheviks took control
- Farmland redistributed
- Workers gained control of factories



Russia under Lenin

- Renamed Bolsheviks to Communist Party
- Russia renamed to the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics or Soviet Union
- Communist Party held all the power
 - Disliked nationalism
- Believed that a <u>vanguard party</u> should take the lead in the communist struggle (Leninism)
- Created the Comintern
 - Spread communism around the world
- New Economic Policy (NEP)
 - Small-scale capitalism



Real communism is actually a classless society. Was Lenin's USSR communist?

Red Terror (1918 – 1922)

- Carried out by the Cheka, secret police
 - Mass killings of political, economic, and social rivals
 - Kulaks, wealth peasants
 - Army deserters
 - Rioters
 - 50,000 1.5 million people dead

White Army did something similar, called White Terror. Thousands killed.



Gulag

- Started during the Red Terror, managed by the Cheka at first
 - Forced labor camps
 - Political prisoners, kulaks, criminals


Power Vacuum


Lenin dies in 1924 from health conditions






Who will succeed Lenin?








Joseph Stalin






Leon Trotsky
