

The Great Depression

 Started in the US in 1929 and spread globally, lasting into the late 1930s

Income, revenue, profits, and prices dropped. Trade dropped by more than 50%

- Unemployment 25% 33% of population
 Many saw democracy as ineffective in dealing with these issues.
- Many countries became protectionist





Fascist Appeal

Fascists promised:

- Revive the economy
- Punish those responsible for hard times
- Restore order and national pride
 - Nation as #1 priority



Capitalist countries are okay with is as long as they're not Communists/Socialists.

Empire of Japan

Rising power in Asia

- Few natural resources, need colonies
- Adopted some form of fascism
 - Militarism
- Aggressively expanded in Asia
 - Greater East Asian Co-Prosperity Sphere
 - Invaded Manchuria (part of China) in 1931
- League of Nations protested as Japan continued
 - Japan withdrew in 1933
- By 1937, Japan launched full-scale invasion of China













Italian and German Aggression in the 1930s

Both takes advantage of failure of League of Nation to prevent Japanese aggression and began building up their military and planned expansion

By 1936, Germany, Italy, and Japan enters an alliance, later known as Axis Powers

- 1935-1936
 - Mussolini invades Ethiopia with 500,000 soldiers
 - Used mustard gas (outlawed by international law, Geneva Protocol in 1925)
 - League of Nations failed to do anything
 - Showed even stronger weakness

German Rearmament

Treaty of Versailles reduced German military to 100,000 for defense, cannot have submarines, make military planes and tanks

Secretly trained air force (Luftwaffe) and tank units in the Soviet Union

1933:

- Germany leaves League of Nations a few months after Japan and begins rebuilding the military
- Declares Third Reich
- Openly ignores Treaty of Versailles in 1935

<u>1936:</u>

- Hitler remilitarizes the Rhineland
 - Great Britain and France did nothing
 - Policy of appeasement





appeasement

Policy or action of pacifying, satisfy, placate someone's demands

Spanish Civil War (1936 — 1939)

Fascists led by Francisco Franco, fought against the liberal and socialist (Republicans)


- Germany and Italy send soldiers to support
- Other countries remained neutral
- Germany used opportunity to test out new military tactics
 - Blitzkrieg (lightning warfare)

Franco won and ruled Spain until 1975

Further Nazi Expansion

Hitler desired "Anschluss," union between Austria and Germany

- Many Austrians supported it
- Austria annexed (added) in March 1938

Hitler turned attention to Czechoslovakia

- New country created from Austrio-Hungarian Empire after WWI; military alliance with France and Great Britain
- 3 million Germans lived in a region called Sudetenland
- Hitler demanded it in September 1938;
 Czechs asked France for help





Munich Conference (September 1938)

Mussolini proposed a meeting with Italy, Germany, France, and Great Britain

Czechs were not invited

France and Great Britain gave Sudetenland to Germany in the Munich Pact


- Vital Czech defense region
- Czechs felt betrayed by allies

Neville Chamberlain, Prime Minister of Great Britain:

• "I believe it is peace for our time."

Aftermath and Continued Appeasement

Six months later, Hitler annexes the rest of Czechoslovakia (March 1939)

Czechs were not invited

Hitler demands return of German territory from Poland

- Britain and France agreed to protect Polish independence
- Hitler and Stalin signs nonaggression pact in August 1939
- Hitler invades Poland in September 1, 1939








France and Great Britain declares war on September 3, 1939


Hitler and Eugenics

Hitler believed in creating the Master Race, the Aryan race

- pale skin, blond hair, blue eyes
- But really, German people
- No defects
- Weak People = Weak Nation

Began to selectively create Master Race through eugenics, a practice of "improving" genetics

- Birth defects, mental illnesses, physical disabilities, homosexuality, hereditary diseases
- "Life unworthy of life"



Hitler and Eugenics (cont.)

Hitler had programs to sterilize (prevent from reproducing) and exterminate "defective" people

- 400,000 sterilized by force
- 300,000 exterminated



Largely influenced by eugenic programs in the United States, especially in <u>California</u>

- Up to 31 states had compulsory sterilization laws
- Some eugenicists sent literature and information to Nazi Germany






Hitler and Jews

Hitler and the Nazi Party blamed the Jews for Germany's problems By the end of WWII, about 6 millions Jews were killed

- Historically easy target to blame for anything
 - A religion and part ethnicity (Israelites)
 - Cultural and religious differences compared to other Europeans







The Beginning of the Holocaust

In 1933, Hitler began passing laws limiting the rights of Jews:

Could not hold government office

Nuremburg Laws (1935)

- Jews are not considered German citizens
- Germans cannot marry Jews
- All law violators are sentenced to hard labor

Starting 1939, Jews forced to live in ghettos, a part of a city where a particular minority group lives, before moving them to concentration camps and the "Final Solution"



In 1941, all Jews in German-occupied territory had to wear a Star of David badge on clothes as identification.
