
The Printing Press and Reformation



Printing Press

- One of the most significant inventions in human history
- Invented by Johannes
 Gutenberg around 1440
- Helped advance the Renaissance, Reformation, and the Enlightenment

Origins of Reformation

- Divine Right Theory
- Catholic Church dominated Europe
- Secular ideas and humanism + printing press weakened the Church's control
- Church selling indulgences (pardons)
- Martin Luther, a German monk, publishes the 95 Theses
 - Complaints about the Church



The Reformation

Divine Rights Theory Holy, Godly

Kings/Queens derived their right to rule directly from God. Also known as Divine Right of Kings.

Martin Luther's Main Ideas

- People can win salvation through faith of God's forgiveness
 - Not indulgences
- All church teachings are based on the Bible
 - Not the pope
- People can interpret the Bible on their own
 - Do not need priests to do it for them



Creation of Protestantism

- Luther and followers became known as Lutherans
- Later all non-Catholic Christians became known as Protestants in general
- Religious wars
- Many more interpretations and Protestant groups emerge
 - Calvinists
 - Anglicans
 - Anabaptists
 - Counter-group Jesuits
