

Impacts

- A better society is possible with reason
- Increase of secular, or worldly, outlook
 - Less emphasis on religion
 - Separate religion from government
 - Tolerance of all religions
- Promotion of the individual
 - Individualism
 - Rely on one's own ability

No taxation without representation!

- Declaration of Independence
 - July 4th, 1776
 - Life, Liberty, Pursuit of Happiness
- Democratic ideas from the Enlightenment




Background before French Revolution

- Ruled by a king
 - Feudalism
 - Centralized control under Louis XIV (Sun King)
- "Old Regime"
- Society
 - The Three Estates

First Estate

- Church & Clergy
- 1-2% of population
- Owned 10% of land
- Paid no taxes
- Can tax people 10% to support Church→
 tithes





Second Estate

- Nobility & aristocracy
- 1-2% of population
- Owned 20% of the land
- Paid 0% taxes
- Reluctant for reform because of privilege



Third Estate

- 96% of the population
- Had no rights and privileges of other estates
- Paid all the taxes
- Bourgeoisie → wealthy business class
- Urban lower class
- Peasant farmers
 - 80%+ of population
 - 50% of income went to taxes







Problems in France (Before 1789)

- Large population
- Crop failures
- Royal extravagance
- Wars
 - Debt
 - Support for American Revolution



Problems in France (Before 1789)

- Louis XVI
 - Louis XIV, Sun King's greatgreat-great grandson
 - Marie Antoinette
 - Austrian archduchess
 - Austria → France's enemy
 - Popular at first but later remembered for being extravagant
 - "Let them eat cake"



Problems in France (Before 1789)

- France running low on money
- Louis XVI calls Estates General meeting in 1789
 - Has not met since 1614
- Estates General assembly of all three estates
- Wanted to tax Second Estate
- Third Estate wanted more rights
 - Life, liberty, democracy
 - Renames itself National Assembly
 - Tennis Court Oath

- Equality, Liberty, and Democracy
